What is the Children's Air Ambulance?

The Children's Air Ambulance is a new and vitally needed service, the first of its kind in Europe. The charity's aim is to provide "free" life saving flights to any child between the ages of newborn and 16 years, who require immediate transfer to a "hospital of excellence" in order to receive the best life saving treatment available, in the quickest time possible.

The Children's Air Ambulance receives no funding from the NHS, Government or National Lottery so we rely on the generosity of the public to fund the operation. Our Flight for Life lottery will provide us with a regular, predictable income which means that we can be sure that the service can continue once we have the helicopter up and flying.

The Children's Air Ambulance will be based at Stapleford Aerodrome, North London. It will be on call 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, to answer any request from one of the specialist children's hospitals in the UK. It will be available to transfer a critically ill child to the specialist unit, best suited for their needs, where they will receive vital life saving treatment. A specialist retrieval team will be flown to the hospital that the child is to be collected from, so that the specialist treatment can begin on the flight to the destination hospital. The service will also provide urgent transplant flights for children, and flights for critically burnt children.

The Children's Air Ambulance will only fly if a child's life is at stake. It will not conduct routine transfers, so in effect, every time we fly, it is because a child could die if we don't!!

Volunteer ground handlers will ensure the aircraft is constantly fuelled, heated, replenished with oxygen etc.. and ready to be launched within 5 minutes of a request to fly. Operations staff will man the telephones 24 hours per day and co-ordinate flight planning, ambulance co-ordination and provide a flight watch service throughout all operations.

The helicopter will be fitted with the very latest in life saving equipment including an incubator for babies. The helicopter can fly in all but the very worst of weather and is fitted with weather radar, GPS systems, autopilots and every modern day feature to allow the pilots to operate the aircraft easily and safely. It has a cruising speed of up to 160 miles per hour, meaning that London to Edinburgh is easily achieved in a little over 1hr 35 minutes.

HOW TO TAKE PART

The easiest way to take part in the Flight for Life Lottery, and help us to save children's lives, is to sign up as a subscription member. The cost is just £1 per week for each ticket, payable by standing order through your bank account. You will receive a membership card containing your lottery numbers which will then be automatically entered into the draw each week. Alternatively you can send a cheque to cover any number of weeks. Simply fill in the form overleaf and post it off to us.
